Due to its practically zero porosity, Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces are highly resistant to chemicals and stains in dayto-day use, making it ideal for use as kitchen countertops or any other surface, both inside and out.

EVERYDAY CLEANING

- Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces are fairly easy to clean. Use a microfiber cloth to remove dust from the surface. Clean your Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces daily if necessary.
- Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces can be washed with warm water, to which a detergent can be added, or any regular, over-the-counter cleaning products. Rinse with warm water and dry with a cloth or similar.
- If liquids are spilled, it must be dried immediately, the faster you clean the spills, the easier it is to remove the stains.
- Do not use products containing hydrofluoric acid and its derivatives.
- It's not advisable to use waxes, oils, soaps, or any impregnating agents. Some detergents may contain waxes or polishing additives that can leave an oily film on the surface.
- Ceramic knives may scratch Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces in any finish.

SUGGESTED DETERGENTS TO CLEAN GENERAL STAINS

Some stains may not be removed by normal cleaning products and operations, and may require specific procedures or products to remove the stain. Contact your local Daltile representative if you need additional assistance in specific cleaning products.
